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RESOLUTION NO. 11270

WHEREAS, Section 2 (1), Article IX-C of the 1987 Constitution grants the Commission on Elections the power to enforce and administer all laws and regulations relative to the conduct of an election, plebiscite, initiative, referendum, and recall;

WHEREAS, on 07 June 2023, the Commission promulgated Resolution No. 10924, entitled "General Guidelines and Other Related Rules and Regulations for the October 30, 2023 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (BSKE) and All Succeeding BSKEs Thereafter";

WHEREAS, on 28 January 2026, the Commission promulgated Resolution No. 11191, entitled "Calendar of Activities and Periods of Certain Prohibited Acts in Connection with the November 2, 2026 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (BSKE)";

WHEREAS, on 18 February 2026, the Commission promulgated Resolution No. 11196, entitled "In the Matter of Amending Pertinent Provisions on the Filing of Certificates of Candidacy Under COMELEC Resolution No. 10924, Entitled

‘General Guidelines and Other Related Rules and Regulations for the October 30, 2023 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (BSKE) and All Succeeding BSKEs Thereafter’ for Purposes of the November 02, 2026 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections;”

WHEREAS, attached to Resolution No. 11196 as Annexes “K” to “K-4” are the Certificate of Candidacy (COC) forms for the position of Punong Barangay; Member, Sangguniang Barangay; Chairperson, Sangguniang Kabataan; and Member, Sangguniang Kabataan for the November 02, 2026 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections;

WHEREAS, on 24 July 2026, the Commission approved the inclusion of a sworn declaration on conflict of interest in the COC;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to its power vested in it by the Constitution, the Omnibus Election Code, and other election laws, the Commission **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to amend the pertinent provisions of Resolution No. 10924 as amended by Resolution No. 11196, to now read as follows:

SECTION 1. *Section 169, Chapter I, Article VII is hereby amended to read as follows:*

“SEC. 169. Contents and forms of Certificate of Candidacy. – The COC shall be under oath and shall state:

a. xxx.

xxx.

t. That the aspirant, once elected, will comply with the provisions on conflict of interest under Republic Act Nos. 3019 and 6713, particularly as to the prohibition on having direct or indirect financial or pecuniary interest in any business, contract, or transaction that may be opposed to or affected by the faithful performance of official duty, or in which he/she is prohibited by the Constitution or any law from having any interest;

u. That the aspirant assumes the foregoing obligations voluntarily without mental reservation or purpose of evasion;

v. That the aspirant shall not advocate violence or unlawful means to achieve one’s goals;

w. That the aspirant gives consent to the Commission to collect, disclose or share, and process the personal data provided for election and other lawful purposes in accordance with the Privacy Notice and as may be authorized by existing laws

x. That the facts stated in the certificate are true and correct to the best of the aspirant's knowledge;

- y. Original signature over the printed name of the aspirant/ candidate or digital signature as defined under existing laws and rules; and
- z. Whether the aspirant has been found liable for an offense/s which carries with it the accessory penalty of perpetual disqualification to hold public office, which has become final and executory.

The updated COC forms with sworn declaration on conflict of interest for the 2026 BSKE are attached as Annexes 'K', 'K-1', 'K-2', and 'K-3'.

SECTION 2. Effectivity. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon publication in at least two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.

SECTION 3. Publication and Dissemination. The Education and Information Department shall cause the publication of this Resolution in at least two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines. The Information Technology Department shall cause the posting of this Resolution in the official website of the Commission.
